Golden Beaver vs Amicus – 27 May 2010

Golden Beaver delivered an appeal of a decision of the protest committee on 27 May 2010 at the Royal Canadian Yacht Club to the CYA on 25 June 2010. The appeal was delegated to the appeals committee of Ontario Sailing for a decision.

Rule 65: Informing the parties and others

Appendix F2.1: Procedures for appeals and requests, Submission of documents

A party to a protest requesting a written copy of a protest committee's decision shall make her request in writing to the protest committee no later than seven days after being informed of the decision.

Although Golden Beaver delivered her appeal approximately two weeks after obtaining the protest committee's written decision, rule 65.2 says a party to a hearing is entitled to receive the protest committee's decision in writing, provided she asks for it in writing from the protest committee no later than seven days after being informed of the decision. Golden Beaver was informed of the protest committee's decision on 27 May 2010. The protest committee did not receive a written request from Golden Beaver for a copy of its written decision.

The appeal of Golden Beaver is therefore refused.
