



NOMINATION CRITERIA

PURPOSE

To acknowledge and recognize the outstanding contribution of an individual or a group of individuals who through his/her and/or their efforts have inspired participation in the recreational and/or competitive sport of sailing in Canada.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

A Canadian or Canadians whose primary residence is in Ontario.

Someone who has contributed a minimum of 10 years to the activity for which he and/or she has been nominated.

Someone who has demonstrated leadership and/or innovation in the activity for which he and/or she has been nominated.

Someone who has donated significant time and energy to improve the quality of and/or participation in the recreational and/or competitive sport of sailing.

EXCLUSIONS

Present members of the Canadian Sailing Team.

Present members of the Ontario Sailing Team.

Anyone currently holding a board position with Ontario Sailing

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

Nominations must be submitted by completing a nomination form.

Members of the Selection Committee may not submit a nomination form.
