

# Ontario Sailing Grand Prix WINDSURFING Development Series

May to September, 2014

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

**1.1** Each regatta in the Grand Prix Development Series (GPDS) will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* including appendix B (rules for windsurfing).

**1.2** All Sail Canada Prescriptions shall apply.

**1.3** The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions for each of the events to count in the GPDS will apply for the scoring and racing requirements of the individual events to count towards the series. See NoR No. 5 below.

**1.4** Class rules for the Techno 293 shall apply unless otherwise specified in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions for each of the individual events comprising the GPDS.

### 3\* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

**3.1** The GPDS is open to windsurfers of the Techno 293 class provided all competitors are less than 19 years of age by 2400 hours on December 31, 2014.

**3.2** Eligible boards may enter by completing the on-line form and submitting it along with a fee of \$10 per boat to Ontario Sailing by July 4, 2014. Late entries will only be accepted if approved by the GPDS Organizing Authority.

### 4 FEES

**4.1** Individual Regatta event fees shall apply if applicable.

### 5 SCHEDULE

**5.1** For registration, membership and inspection, please refer to the Notice of Race and/or Sailing Instructions of the individual events to be counted in the GPDS.

**5.2** Regattas comprising the GPDS and their dates for Techno 293:

TWC #3            July 12, 2014

TWC #4            September 20, 2014

## **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available at each event.

## **7 SCORING**

**7.1** There will not be separate scoring for males and females.

**13.1** The scoring system is as follows:

- a)** Each regatta of the series will be scored according to the NoR and Si's for that event.
- b)** A board's score in the GPDS will be based on her best three results of the above events comprising the GPDS for each class (See NoR No. 5).
- c)** A score of DNC for an event shall be based on the final number of registered competitors of the GPDS for each class plus one.
- d)** The low point scoring system will be used.

**13.2** After each GPDS Event, the current leader of each class will be required to wear a yellow pinny over their life vest to signify that they are the front running boat in the class.
