Sailing at the BCC starts with our Juniors. The Club provides beginner and advanced sailing lessons in the shelter of the bay for our children and adults who would like to get more involved. They will learn to sail, have a great summer experience and make friends along the way. Our certified staff of sailing instructors combined with safe, modern equipment assures positive results and pure enjoyment. Our junior activities program also offers day camp, tennis and swimming lessons. Our sailing program alone attracts 200 participants from all different skill levels.

The Junior program prides itself on Junior regattas. Last summer our 420 class participated in the Junior Olympics in Rochester as well as the Club 420 North American Championships in Manteo, North Carolina. We also have a very active fleet of O'Pen Bics, who participated in Junior Olympics in Rochester as well as travelling to the Cleveland Yacht Club to race against CYC sailors. If travelling with our juniors to these regattas, we offer regatta pay as well as all expenses covered.

Our Clubhouse has a snack bar located on the main floor. While being employed here we will offer you a 50% discount on all purchases.

Complete all other reasonable tasks or duties assigned by JA Manager.

Complete First Aid/CPR Training.

Complete daily duties. Ex: Beach Duty, Coach Duty, Cleaning Duties

Must be available for Wednesday night racing

After class private lessons as well as and Saturday lessons, will be optional (additional pay)
