Notice of race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. Under RRS 87, rule(s) 3.7.1, of the J 24 class rules (are) changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Boats will compete with crew of four with a maximum crew weight (in swim wear) of 320kg.
 - 1.2.2. The boats shall sail with one mainsail, one jib and one spinnaker that comply with J-24 class rules.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Laser, Laser Radial, J24, 49er, 49erFX, and Lightning Classes.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by applying online by completing on line registration form found at www.rcyc.ca, by Friday September 19th, 2014
- 3.3. Successful applicants will be informed and invited to the event no later than Friday September 26th, 2014
- 3.4. The following restriction on the number of boats apply:

4. FEES

- 4.1. Required fees are as follows:

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.5. The sailing instructions will be available after 11:00 am On Wednesday October 15th, 2014 online at www.rcyc.ca
- 4.6. On Sunday October 19th no warning signal will be made after 1430 hours

5. VENUE

- 5.1. Attachment 1 shows the location of the racing areas. If conditions warrant the PRO may elect to run both Race courses in the harbour

6. THE COURSES

6.1. The diagrams in Attachment 2 show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

7.1. For the all classes RRS 44.1 and P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

7.2. Appendix P will apply as changed by NOR 9.1.

8. SCORING

1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When more than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. BERTHING

9.1. Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park located at 150 Cherry Street

10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

10.1. Keelboats shall be hauled out and kept in their assigned places during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

11. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

11.1. Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. PRIZES

13.1. Prizes will be given as follows: top three for all classes.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

15.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
