Rules

The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility

The regatta is open to all competitors with a valid High School student card in the following classes: Laser, Laser Radial, 420, 29er. In the event the skipper and crew are from different high schools, the skipper's school will be used. **Each competitor must obtain their Principal's approval to race under your High school's name, verbal approval is ok. Failure to obtain approval will result in disqualification. If your Principal will not approve you to race under your school name you can still race and be scored but your school will not be considered for the Ontario Sailing High School Award.**

Fees/ Registration

Registration fee is \$30 in advance or \$40 cash on race day 8:00am to 10:00am. (includes a \$2 Ontario Sailing fee) per person which will include a hot breakfast and BBQ dinner after racing. BHYC will provide Ontario Sailing each participant's name, age, and address. Competitors are encouraged to preregister [here](#) prior to the event.

Sailing Instructions / schedule

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. Breakfast starts at 8:30am. Skippers meeting will be held at 10:30am. Launch will begin at 10:45am. The first gun will be at 11:30am. No race will start after 3:30pm. No food or water will be supplied on the water. The intent is for the competitors to eat a good breakfast prior to racing and be back on shore by 4:15 so they can de-rig and be ready for an early BBQ dinner starting at 4:45pm.

Courses

A maximum of 5 races will be sailed on windward/ leeward or triangle course.

Prizes

Prizes will be given to first, second and third place finishers, skipper and crew if applicable. Awards will be given out as close to 5:30pm as possible depending on number of protests.

Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. BHYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
