The club owns a fleet of 18 Albacores certified by the Canadian Albacore Association. We will run four CANSail 1 & 2, and two CANSail 3 classes, with approximately 16 students per class, on both weekday evenings (Tuesday and Thursday) and weekends (Mostly Saturdays), starting in late April and ending in late August.

The ideal instructors will be enthusiastic, driven to take initiatives, and have excellent communication and leadership skills. The ability to instruct and motivate adult students of all ages from diverse backgrounds and nautical experience levels.

Requirements:

- Be a current CANSail1-2 coach or Greater
- Have valid Standard First Aid and CPR
- Have a valid PCOC
- Have a Toronto Port Authority Powered Vessel Operator's permit, or intent to obtain one
- Be in good standing with Sail Canada
