The Learn to Sail Head Instructor is a leader who is dedicated to providing safe, fun and quality instruction for young sailors.

Responsibilities:

- --Ability to provide a safe and fun environment to participants in programs with DYC.
- --Teach, coach and supervise Learn to Sail programs for the season.
- --Ability to communicate effectively with a wide range of people associated with the programs including participants, parents, volunteers and other staff.
- --Organizing and maintaining sailboat and coach boat fleet in good repair.
- --Maintain all relevant and required records.
- --Work productively with other staff and volunteers to deliver high quality programs.
- --Attend all scheduled staff training events and meetings.
- --Maintain and upgrade as required, certifications and qualifications.
- --Manage and mentor the instructional team including assisting with coaching when necessary.
- --LTS Head instructor reports to the LTS Committee.

Qualifications: Preference given to candidates with the following knowledge, skills, abilities, experience, and qualifications:

- --Minimum one season of experience as a sailing instructor in a learn to sail program.
- --Current Standard First Aid and CPR (AED training an asset).
- --Certified CANSail Instructor, ideally CANSail 1&2 and CANSail 3&4 Certified.
- --Registered Instructor in good standing with Sail Canada for 2019.
- --ROC(M) VHF Radio Operators Certificate.
- --Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC).

- --Racing Experience an asset.
- --Vulnerable Sector Screening (contingent upon hiring).
