
Gods in My Home: Chinese New Year with Ancestor Portraits and Deity Prints

This new installation showcases almost all of the Hal Jackman Toy Soldier Collection, which traces the historic life span of Britains Ltd., one of the world's pioneers in the manufacturing of toy soldiers. Visitors are invited to enjoy the artistry and detail of this outstanding collection, and learn about the legacy of Britains Ltd.'s years of lead toy production from 1893-1966.
