Candidates who are interested in applying for Head Instructor are strongly encouraged to spend time in this role first. Prior experience teaching at KYC is not essential. Applicants should have a **strong sailing and teaching background** and should have or be committed to completing advanced instructor qualifications. The Jr. Head Instructor will be expected to assist in coaching wherever needed. Other strengths of interest are **creativity, organization, team management, conflict resolution, safety and customer service.** Dates of employment will run roughly from the beginning of June to the end of August.

Successful candidates should have:

- Current Sail Canada Instructor Certification or equivalent qualification, with a minimum of one year instructing
- Current Sail Canada Instructor prerequisites (First Aid, CPR, PCOC, Boat Safety)
- Police Background Check (Vulnerable Sector Screening for the Junior Sailing program)
- Racing experience considered an asset
- Experience with multiple boats (including Opti, 420, 29er etc.) considered an asset

- Instructors are encouraged to participate in race nights with KYC members (Tues and Thurs), and pursue personal sailing/regattas
