The club owns a fleet of 18 Albacores and runs 4 CANSail 1 & 2, and 2 CANSail 3 classes, with 16 – 24 students per class, on both weekdays and weekends, starting in early May and ending in early August.

The ideal Instructors will be enthusiastic, driven to take initiatives, and have excellent communication skills. In addition, the instructors must be mature, responsible and energetic club ambassadors, with abilities to instruct and motivate adult students of all ages, and from diverse backgrounds and nautical experiences.

Minimum requirements include:

- A current White Sail Coach/CANSail 1&2 Instructor (or higher)
- Current Emergency First Aid
- A valid PCOC
- Toronto Port Authority Powered Vessel Operator's permit (we offer help in obtaining the permit)

Responsibilities:

- Oversee student safety
- Evaluate students on Can sail criteria
- Prepare Pre and Post sailing lessons including instruction and feedback
- Assist head instructor as required
- Make sure that students report any damage that may occur during a lesson
- Report any issues with functioning of powerboats
- Always be prepared to sail in the conditions you coach in
- Assign meal task to students
- Drive your own Power Boat!
- Refuel Power Boat as required and report issues as required
- Promote the community club spirit!
- Go sailing (outside of lessons)!
