Overview

The aim of the Sailing School is to introduce new adult sailors to the fundamentals of sailing; to help them learn to sail safely and to have fun. Sailing club members assist with in-dinghy supervision as required, and with dinghy setup, maintenance, and repairs. Opportunities to crew in the club's informal Friday night races and BBQs are available to students (and instructors if interested!) as well as trial membership in the club for a nominal fee for successful graduates of the program.

The club uses Sail Canada's CANSail dinghy program to bring students to the **CANSail 1 or 2** competency level.

Nature and Scope

SBSC is seeking 1 to 3 CANSail 1 & 2 certified Sailing Instructor(s) for the 2021 season; we are happy to hire experienced or newly certified instructors. Individuals in this role will be responsible for the delivery of customer service excellence through participant satisfaction and safety during all instructional sessions as well as in everyday interactions with club members, participants and their families.

Instructors will be required to attend a club boat safety orientation, sign our instructor concussion policy form, and familiarize and follow our Covid-19 School Safety plan.

- Teach, coach and supervise adult sailing courses
- Provide on the water instruction & review of student performance
- Ability to communicate effectively with a wide range of people associated with the programs, including but not limited to participants, club members, and volunteers
