Nature and Scope

Lac Deschênes Sailing Club (LDSC) is seeking a qualified and enthusiastic Head Sailing Instructor, with strong interpersonal skills, for our Youth and Adult sailing lessons. Required skills include Sail Canada Certified Instructor for CANSail Levels I/II/III and IV completed by June 1, 2022.

Responsibilities

- Ability to provide a safe and fun environment to participants in programs with LDSC.
- Teach, coach and supervise our programs for the season.
- Ability to communicate effectively with a wide range of people associated with the programs, including but not limited to participants, parents, volunteers and other staff.
- Play a role in ensuring the equipment used remains clean and in good repair throughout season.
- Maintain all relevant and required records.
- Work productively with other staff and volunteers to deliver high quality programs.
- Attend all scheduled staff training events and meetings.
- Maintain and upgrade as required certifications and qualifications.

Main tasks include:

- Organizing and conducting Adult Sail training with assistant instructors on the following dates: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday evenings, from May 31 to Friday June 25;
- Organizing and conducting Youth Sail Training Camps with assistant instructors on the following dates: July 4 to July 29, except for July 1, and Aug 8th to 12th, weekdays from 8:30 to 4:30; and
- Providing racing assistance with assistant instructors, as required, on Wednesday Evenings (17:30 to 21:00) and Sunday Afternoons (12:00 to 16:30); and support at Regatta and various racing events (to be confirmed) starting in July;

- Help with boat repairs and house & grounds tasks.

- Certificate of radio operation training - VHF/ROC
- Minimum 16 years of age
- Registered instructor in good standing with Sail Canada/ROWONTARIO
