Qualifications:

As a minimum*, our preferred candidates will:

- Be available from May 1 to September 1, 2023
- Be able to certify CANSail 3&4 (or higher). Completion of the CANSail Program Manager module is considered an asset
- Be able to demonstrate up-to-date Sail Canada prerequisites and the payment of annual instructor dues
- Be able to perform basic boat maintenance
- Be capable of inspiring sailors, parents, and instructors to embrace the sport of sailing
- Be confident in their leadership, communication, and administrative abilities
- Be able to liaise effectively with the Boulevard Club Yachting Director
- Be enthusiastic, professional and demonstrate a true passion for youth sailing

- Ensure coaches provide progress reports, Sail Canada checklists updates, and end of session interviews for their athletes
- Disseminate regular communications to athletes, parents, and coaches about Sailing School events
- Provide supervision during athlete arrival, lunchtime, and departure
- Lead staff meetings and curriculum development planning
- Perform daily opening and closing duties, maintenance and cleanliness of sailboat fleet, coach boat fleet, coaching equipment, instructional spaces, and physical plant
- Provide an inclusive, welcoming, and flexible learning environment for all participants, families, and coaches.
