- Mentor senior sailors to assist them on the path of becoming instructors;
- Oversee the Junior social events (including movie nights, fun nights, Friday night dances, etc.) (Note: senior sailors traditionally assist/lead in organizing these events; the Assistant Head will have overall oversight and responsibility for these events.)
- Fleet oversight & boat maintenance; and
- Other duties as may be reasonably assigned
