BQYC's Junior Sailing school, Youth Race Team, and Adult Learn-to-Sail programs offer youth and adult sailors the opportunities to develop foundational sailing skills, as well as water safety training and an athletic mindset leading to lifelong healthy lifestyles.

The Bay of Quinte Yacht Club Junior Sail Training program is seeking applications from qualified individuals for the following position:

Junior Sailing Instructor

This position requires a recently qualified or certified CANSail 1/2 instructor. Junior Sailing Instructors will be introducing young sailors to sailing with the goal of creating a lifelong passion for the sport of sailing.

The instructional program runs for eight weeks in July and August. Instructors start the last week of June for safety training and orientation, and finish the last week of August to prepare equipment for winter storage.

- Current standard first aid, CPR certification and Boat Safety certification

- Marine VHF Operator Certificate (ROC(M)) (preferred, not required)
- Racing and regatta experience are assets
