We offer a fun, supportive, safe, inclusive, affordable, and high-quality camp in Toronto that gives young people the opportunity to try and enjoy sailing.

OHSF Water Sport Camp offers CANSail instruction in Optimists, RS QBA's, RS Zests, R/S Quests, R/S Visions, and C420s. Our program is taught in one and two-week blocks during the summer.

- Be available from June 26 to August 25, 2023
- Be able to certify CANSail 1&2 or 3&4 (or higher)
- Have up-to-date Sail Canada prerequisites and the payment of annual instructor dues
- Be enthusiastic, professional, and proactive, and demonstrate a true passion for youth sailing

### **Position Overview:**

- Provide ongoing feedback to athletes including progress reports, Sail Canada checkclick updates, and end-of-session interviews
- Work with other instructors to ensure the smooth overall operation of the programs
- Interact with sailors and parents
- Developing and delivering CANSail lessons appropriate for sailors' level
- Provide supervision of sailors both on land and water
- Perform daily opening and closing duties, maintenance and cleanliness of sailboat fleet, coach boat fleet, coaching equipment, and instructional spaces
- Reporting to Head Instructor and Program Manager
- Ensure all policies and protocols, especially health and safety protocols, are always followed
- Other duties as may be reasonably assigned by the Head Instructor as required
- Provide an inclusive, welcoming, and flexible learning environment for all participants, families, and coaches
