Position Overview:

- Instruct CANSail 3 or 4 (or as assigned by the head instructor as registration numbers dictate);
- Lead the afternoon Learn to Race development program (LTR, for CAN 1-3 sailors) and provide a fun/safe environment for sailors to learn the basics of racing and improve their sailing skills (enlist other instructors in the LTR program as necessary.)
- Organize and plan summer training & regatta schedules, as necessary, for the LTR program.
- Support the senior race coach when needed and attend off-site regattas as required. (If you attend off-site regattas, you will receive a per diem to cover expenses.)
- Work with other instructors, to ensure the smooth overall operation of the club
- Other duties as may be reasonably assigned, including assisting with afternoon race and outreach programs
- Fleet oversight & boat maintenance
- Weekly Checkclick data entry and progress reports for sailors
- Participate and provide supervision at the Junior social events (including movie nights, fun nights, Friday night dances, etc.)
