CANSail 3/4 Instructor

We are looking for a dedicated and experienced CANSail 3/4 instructor. This position is a key pillar of our learn to sail program developing the skills of young sailors most who have completed CANSail 1/2 levels in previous years. CANSail 3/4 is taught using our C-420s, or in some cases RS Fevas. Sailors in CANSail 3/4 typically sail for 4 weeks and compete in one local regatta. The CANSail 3/4 instructor plays an important part in identifying candidates to join our racing teams. Our core program runs for eight weeks in July and August. Instructors work an additional week at the start and end of the season for set up and close down of the program. We are looking for candidates with the following skills and qualifications:

- CanSail 3/4 Instructor certification
- Previous experience working with young students (typically in the 10 to 16 year old range)
- Good communications skills with students, parents and other staff
- Able to perform duties and problem solve with a minimum of supervision whilst functioning in a team
- Strong organization skills
- Relevant sailing background
- Knowledge of the racing rules of sailing
- Technical understanding of the C420 and RS Feva dinghies, rigging and basic maintenance
- Instructor dues paid and registered with Sail Canada for 2024
- Current first aid certification
- Boat safety certification
- Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC)
- Marine VHF Operator Certificate (ROC(M))
- Police Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening
- Available for work June 24, 2024 to Aug 30, 2024, including some weekends for regattas
