Head Instructor Position

The Head Instructor will take ownership over the sailing programming at The Ojibway Club. The Head Instructor will be a senior staff team member and report to the General Manager. They will be able to live up in Pointe au Baril for the length of their employment, from July to mid-August.

The Head Instructor is someone with a safety-first mindset and strong leadership and communication skills gained from previous coaching experience. Racing experience is an asset. The Head Instructor is charged with setting up a new CANSail program for older children and teens, along with teaching an Adult Learn to Sail program a couple of days a week. This is new programming offered at the Ojibway so the Head Instructor needs to be self-directed and motivated to create a high energy, fun environment for learn to sail and race.

They will have the help of a small sailing advisory committee of members and the Commodore. We welcome fresh enthusiasm and willingness to try new ideas to make the program successful. Other responsibilities include, class organization, managing boat rentals, supervising and mentoring staff. They will have the assistance of 1-2 camp counselors.
